Lead Mobile Mammography Technologist

Description:

- Serves as the Lead Mobile Mammography technologist for the delivery of mobile mammography procedures on Dana-Farber's Mammography Van.
- This position reports to the Breast Imaging Supervisor, Dana-Farber Imaging Department and collaborates with the Program Manager, Dana-Farber's Mammography Van Mobile Health.
- Position oversees the technical aspects of mobile mammography delivery in collaboration with the Mammography Supervisor and the relationship building with community health center patients and staff.
- Performs all technical procedures associated with breast imaging studies.
- Assumes lead responsibility for mobile mammography regulatory inspection and accreditation activities (e.g., DPH inspection and ACR).
- Ensures that all imaging equipment and devices associated with the technical aspects of the mobile unit are operating as designed.
- Coordinates appropriate preventive maintenance and initiates service calls as needed.
- Participates in the evaluation and selection of replacement equipment.
- Manages supply inventory by following a materials management program to ensure supply availability and cost.
- Manages the QC program via the oversight of technologist imaging, data entry, daily/weekly/quarterly and annual quality control.
- Ensures staff adherence to appropriate DFCI, OSHA, JCAHO, NRC/PDH, ACR and other applicable regulatory guidelines.
- Maintains open communication with the Breast Imaging Supervisor and Program Manager Mammography Van regarding technical operations, workflow, staffing and equipment needs.
- Works with the Breast Imaging Supervisor, Program Manager and Administrative and Imaging technologist support staff to coordinate patient flow by monitoring computer and scheduling systems.
- Assists Breast Imaging Supervisor and Program Manager in ensuring that department and patient information (e.g., imaging, data, demographics and reports) are properly and securely managed.
- Participates in the QIA/QI program through data collection and ensure adherence to all established DFCI standards.
- Position requires demonstrated ability to work with other community-based human service organizations.
- Demonstrated flexibility with patients' priorities, evolving needs, and goals with sensitivity to ethnic, cultural, gender, sexual orientation, values, beliefs and behaviors.
- Strong interpersonal skills to explain procedures and to allay the apprehension of patients and to interact effectively with a variety of Institute staff and outside personnel.
- Ability to problem solve issues when resources are stretched or scarce.
- Ability to make alternative plans as needed.
- Ability to mentor, guide and motivate others through demonstration of best practices and leading by example.
